

David Creeson Jr.

David M. Creeson Jr., 57, 717 W. Boulevard, died at Indiana University Hospital in Indianapolis at 6:40 a.m. Tuesday, April 20, 1982.

He was born in Kokomo Dec. 13, 1924, a son of David M. and Amanda (Springer) Creeson Sr.. He was married Aug. 19, 1948, to Doris Duncan, who survives. 21 APR 1982

Also surviving are a son, David A. Creeson, and a daughter, Carol Barker, both of Kokomo; three brothers, Roger and Harold Creeson, both of Kokomo R.R. 3, and Virgil Creeson of Riviera Beach, Fla.; and two grandchildren. A sister and a brother preceded him in death.

Creeson had owned various restaurants in Kokomo and served with the Navy during World War II and the Korean War. He was a member of Kokomo Elks Lodge, Howard Masonic Lodge, Scottish Rite Valley of Indianapolis and Kokomo Shrine Club.

Services will be at 1 p.m. Thursday at Bible Baptist Church with the Rev. Eddle Smith officiating. Entombment will be at Sunset Memory Gardens Mausoleum. Calling at Ellers Mortuary will be from 3 to 5 and 6 to 9 p.m. today, and at the church Thursday an hour before services.
