Donald R. Jackson, 44, 1507 Bulck Lane, was dead on arrival at Howard Community Hospital at 1:25 a.m. Tuesday. He had become ill earlier.

Born Jan. 29, 1929, in Gary, he was the son of Harry and Maguerite (Hoffman) Jackson. He was married Feb. 13, 1954 to Martha Mathew, who survives.
