Marjorie R. Kauffman, 77, Vero Beach, Fla., formerly of Kokomo, died 9:15 p.m. Wednesday, July 7, 2004, at VNA Hospice House in Vero Beach. Born July 16, 1926, in Kokomo, she was the daughter of Roy G. and Ruth L. (Aikman) Barker. On Feb. 5, 1949, in Kokomo, she married A. Cutler "Cut" Kauffman and he survives.
