

Robert Knisely, Union Official, Died in Home

Robert J. Knisely, 64, 211 E. Boulevard, died at 4:25 p.m. Tuesday in his home following apparent heart attack.

An employe of the Kokomo Spring Company; he was the financial secretary of the United Steel Workers Union.

He was a member of the City Traffic Commission; the Howard County Sheriff's Merit Board, the Loyal Order of Moose, the Kokomo Stamp Club and the Union Street Friends Church.

Born June 21, 1907, in Kokomo, he was the son of Walter and Alma (Zook) Knisely. *10 May 1972*

He had served in the U. S. Air Force during World War II.

On April 19, 1943, he was married to Yvonne Petty, who survives with two sons, William Lee Knisely, at home, and Robert J. Knisely Jr., serving with the U. S. Army in Sogel, Germany, and a brother, Eugene Knisely, Kokomo.
