## Kokomoan Listed Dead in Vietnam

Army Pfc. Larry S. Newburn of Kokomo has been declared dead by the Defense Department. He had been listed as missing and presumed drowned Aug. 29 when a raft on which his reconnaissance patrol was riding overturned while crossing a turbulent river in Vietnam.

Born in Kokomo on Sept. 10, 1947, he was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Ben H. Newburn, 1927 W. Havens St.

A 1965 graduate of Kokomo High School, he had been student manager of its varsity football and baseball teams. He entered the U.S. Army last November and took basic training at Ft. Knox, Ky., and received advanced infantry training at Ft. Polk, La. He arrived in Vietnam on May 12 this year.

He was a former sportswriter for the Kokomo Morning Times.

Surviving with the parents are a sister, Linda Kay Newburn, and two brothers, James Alan and Brian Keith Newburn, all at home; and three grandparents, Mrs. Bessie Newburn, Kokomo, and Mr. and Mrs. Milton Kingseed, Greentown.

Memorial services are set for 2:30 p.m. Sunday in the Main Street Church of Christ, 618 S. Main St.
