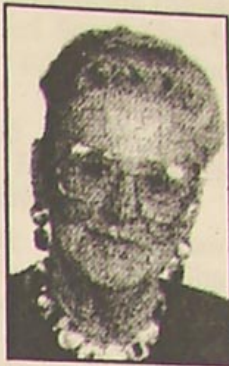


Opal Sallee
