

# **Mrs. Schelbert, Former School Teacher, Dies**

Mrs. Ethel Olive Schelbert, 61, 904 E. Spraker St., died at 12:45 a.m. Thursday in her home following an extended illness.

Born in Ervin Township, Oct. 14, 1906, she was the daughter of Eli and Rosa Lee (Rusk) Bird. She had lived in this community most of her life with the exception of a few years spent in Burlington and Francisville.
