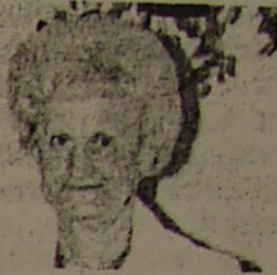


Taylor services
