Harold L. Yoder, 84, 3017 S. 1250 E., Greentown, died 10:07 a.m. Sunday, Jan. 2, 2005, at Howard Regional Health System Emergency Room. Born March 29, 1920, he was a son of Tobias Yoder and Alice (Helmuth) Yoder Demaree. On Feb. 2, 1946, in Kokomo, he married Helen M. (Gaskins) Yoder and she died in 1993.
